• Update- Liquid Waste Program- Chris reported that the DEA has contacted Cargill regarding the remaining information needed. The first loads are targeted to begin coming to the landfill mid-April.

Landfill Manager's Report

- Leachate Recirculation- we are recirculating as much leachate as possible.
- Extra tonnage-Buried ash material from Cargill has been coming in hauled by Behrle. On Monday March 3rd, we received 23 loads.
- Contractors hauling house demolition waste has been picking up.
- Wind Screens-three of the four are done.
